NOVEMBER STUDY SESSION

During its third study session, held on November 20, 2018, the Board of Education heard from experts in the community regarding issues affecting the health, safety, and well-being of our students, as well as how the district is addressing them.

Dr. Elizabeth Meeker, Director, Practice Transformation, Coordinated Care Services, Inc., provided information regarding Adverse Childhood Experiences (also known as ACE's) and youth risk behavior throughout the county. Lynn Carragher, Assistant to the Superintendent for Inclusive Education, explained the impact on Brockport. She also discussed the tools that the district is using to build resiliency in our students to overcome ACE's and reduce risky behavior. Monroe County Sheriff Todd Baxter concluded the presentation with what law enforcement is seeing as far as those ACE's and how they are supporting the community to mitigate those risks.

The December 18, 2018 Executive Study Session will allow Board Members the opportunity to hear from legal counsel regarding contract negotiations. Please note Executive Session activities are closed to the public.
