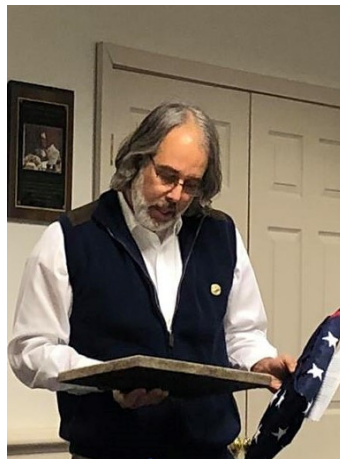
BROCKPORT'S BEST
