The Board of Education expects that Brockport Central School District to be a leading, innovative, high-performing school district that graduates each student prepared for college or a career. Each year, New York State administers ELA/Literacy and Mathematics Assessments in April and May that are designed to measure student proficiency in the knowledge and skills students need to succeed in college and careers. iReady is the tool the District uses to measure students' academic skills in reading, and to help teachers design individualized instruction for them.

During its second study session, the Board of Education will review Brockport's 2018 ELA/Literacy and Mathematics Assessment results in comparison to previous years, as well as graduation rates, Regents and Advanced Placement performance, and other scholastic metrics. The Board will also review the District's use of iReady. We encourage students, parents, and other interested community members to attend this important session.

**As part of its initiative to further engage with the community on important school issues, the Board of Education will dedicate the second meeting of each month to publicly study and discuss matters of interest or concern that affect the District. Every session will include the opportunity for public comment.*
