The Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA) is a federal law that governs K-12 public education policy. ESSA has accountability targets, periodic standardized tests and numerous data tracking and analysis obligations for school districts.

During its inaugural study session, the Board of Education will examine ESSA's mandates and what they mean for the Brockport Central School District. Regardless of mandates, the Board will discuss how to ensure the success of every Brockport student. The Board will also consider options Brockport can undertake to advocate for changes to better aid our students and instructional faculty. There will be an opportunity for public comment at the end of the session.
